


None But Christ Can Satisfy




1. O Christ, in Thee, my soul hath found, And found in Thee a - lone,

4. The pleas - ures lost I sad - ly mourn'd, But nev - er wept for Thee,




The peace, the joy I sought so long, The bliss till now un - known.
