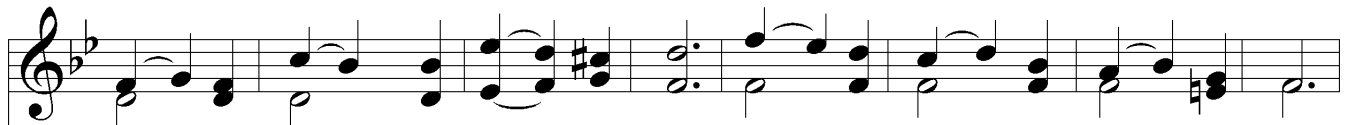


Jesus, Master, Whose I Am

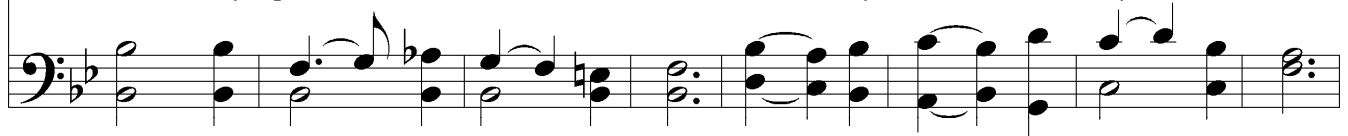
COMPTON 7s, Six Lines.
