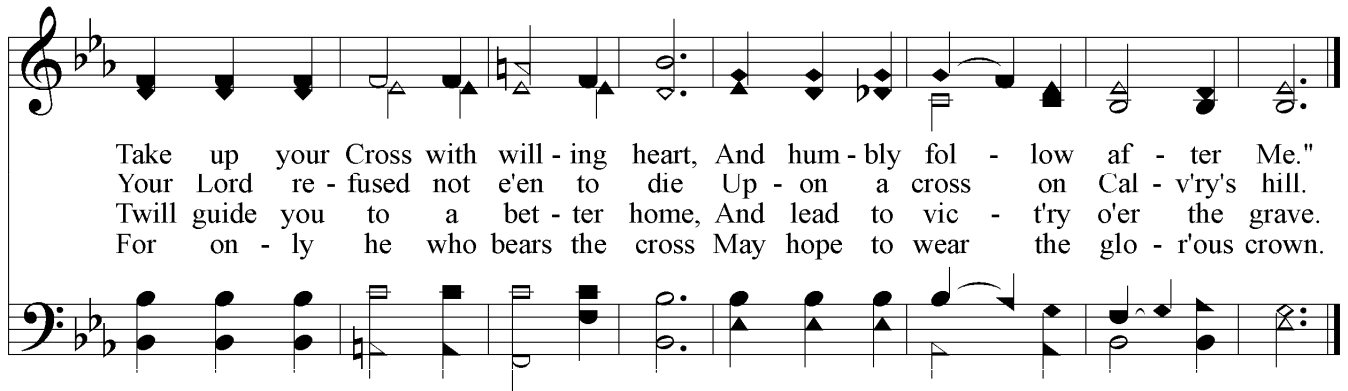


# TAKE UP YOUR CROSS
