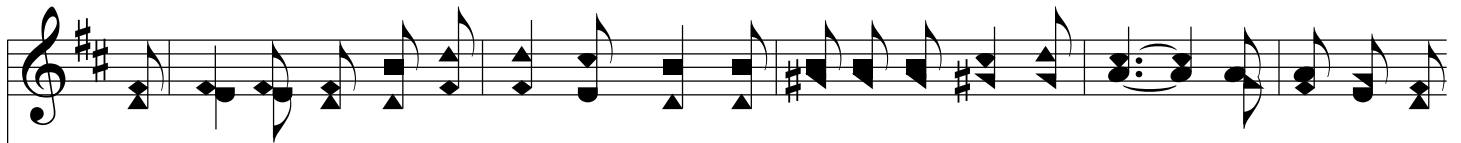

4. O match - less Sav - ior, I yield to Thee My heart, so full of sin;



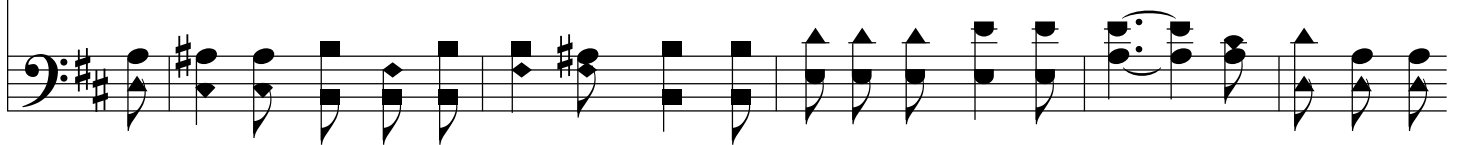
